

C.D.C. Luxury Chains acquired by Lampa (White Bridge) (translated)

C.D.C. Luxury Chains, a private Italian operator for the fashion industry, has been acquired by Lampa, an Italian manufacturer of plastic and metal accessories for the high fashion industry controlled by the fund White Bridge, according to the Italian website *Dealflower*.

The report, which cites White Bridge's Chairman Marco Pincioli, said that the bidder has been assisted by Pedersoli as legal advisor, Athena Associati for the financial due diligence and Bilma for the environmental due diligence. C.D.C. Luxury Chains has been served by DoiT and Slcg.

C.D.C. Luxury Chains posted EUR 14.2m revenues in 2021, according to the information provider Cerved.
